#### **Fund objective**

The OMR FTF Western Asset Retirement Income Bond fund invests solely in the FTF Western Asset Retirement Income Bond fund, a sub fund of Franklin Templeton Funds II, a UK authorised Investment Company with Variable Capital, managed by Franklin Templeton Fund Management Limited. The underlying fund aims to provide a regular income stream, in excess of the prevailing level of interest rates in the U.K., with a focus on capital preservation, by investing in a range of fixed interest securities including, but not limited to, corporate bonds, government bonds and asset backed securities. The underlying fund may be denominated in or hold assets in a currency other than Sterling. The performance of the fund may therefore rise and fall as a result of exchange rate fluctuations. The underlying fund invests in noninvestment grade high-yielding bonds. The high yield reflects a higher risk of capital loss through default. The underlying fund invests in bonds or money market instruments (including deposits with banks or other financial institutions). 
